Variative Education in the Changing World: Socio-Cultural Perspective of the Primary School Development

Abstract. The paper reflects the ideas of the author (one of the new educational standard developers) concerning the prospects of primary school evolution, published in *the Educational Policy* journal in 2011, being still relevant due to the introduction of the Federal Act on Education from September 1, 2013.
